## Regular Inspection of Fall Protection Equipment

Routine inspections are essential to ensure fall protection equipment is safe to use. Inspections should be done both before each use and on a regular schedule to check for wear or damage.

- **Pre-Use Inspection:** Before each use, workers should visually check for any obvious signs of wear or damage. Always refer to the equipment's user manual for specific instructions on inspection.
- **Scheduled Inspections:** Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for regular inspections. Per ANSI/ASSP Z359.2-2023, a Competent Person should inspect fall protection equipment at least once a year.
- **Training:** As per OSHA regulations, a Competent Person should evaluate equipment to ensure safety compliance. It's essential that anyone handling inspection and maintenance of safety equipment has undergone proper Competent Person training.
